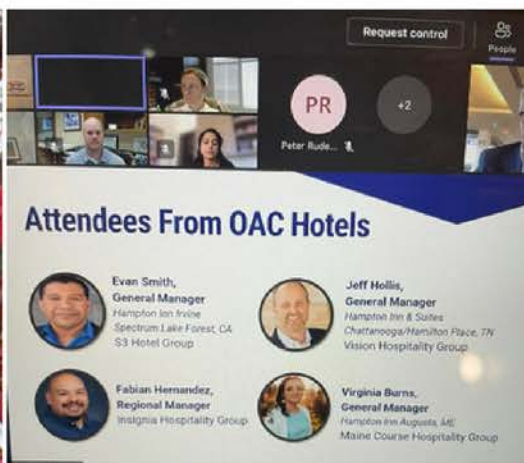
Kim Dennis, GM of the Homewood Suites, Portland, ME wins Heart of Homewood Award

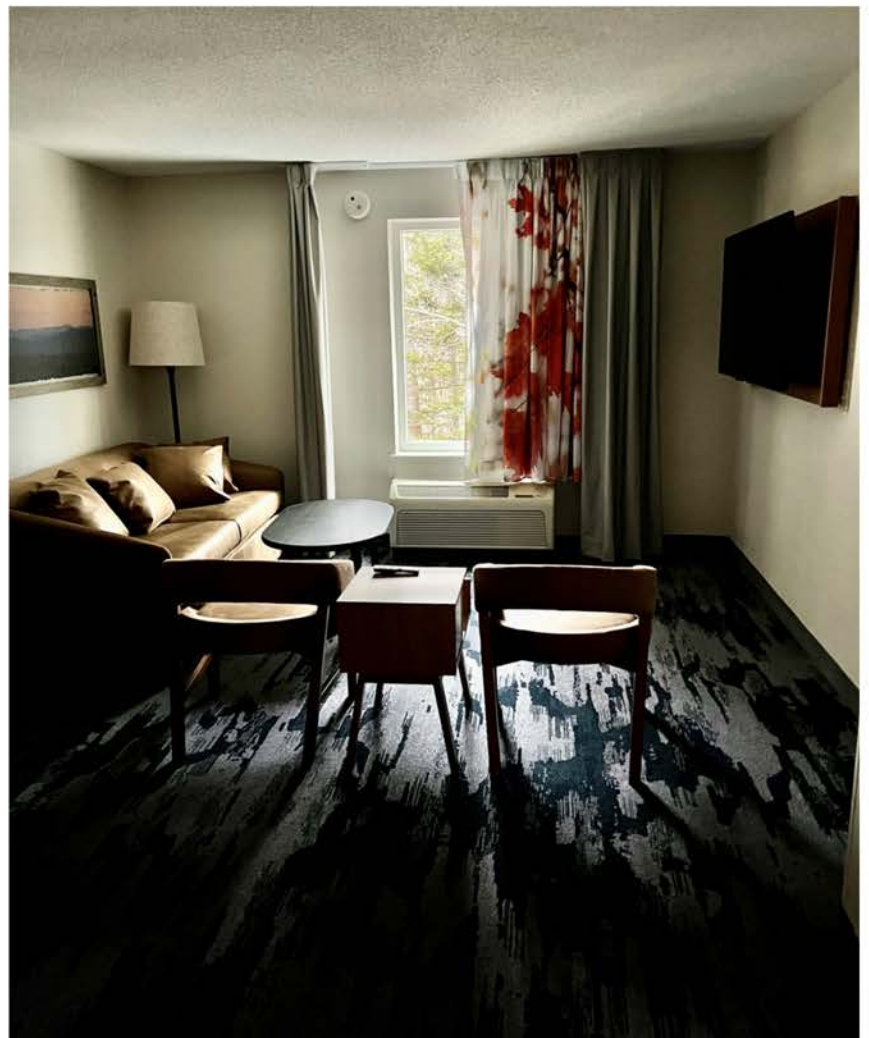
