# And From the Horner Corner





Housekeeping left us a HANDWRITTEN note of welcome. I've never had that, even at The Ritz in South Beach. The room was spotless, even in the corners. We enjoyed the private balcony. The beds were very comfy. The oversized towels and washcloths were great and the quantity was perfect. I was traveling with my son so the sink vanity being separated from shower/toilet worked really well. You have ample FREE parking. I would definitely stay here again. Thank you.

I rarely give anyplace 5 stars across the board but the RHH deserves a high score. The people are genuinely nice. No, fantastic. I travel a lot for work and stay in Marriott's and other chains. The people are forced to smile at you and say "good day to you sir". Quite fake. The staff at the RHH just treat you as you want to be treated - with respect for your needs while staying there.

I should have started with you will never stay in a cleaner hotel, it's pristine. They constantly upgrade to keep things fresh and recently added an outdoor, gas fire pit which is great.

I will say that this is a hotel, not an Inn and maybe lacks that homey feel. It's on a busy but not loud road and overlooks the bay but it's not so picturesque. They make up for it with cleanliness and comfort. The beds are great and the linens clean.

We were there to celebrate my son's 7th birthday and you guys made it very special to him from the moment we arrived to our room. He loved the decorations on the door and the little gift that was waiting for him inside... Thank you for doing that for him and for taking such great care of us during our visit to Maine.

I needed to use a printer and I was directed to the business center computer. It didn't print my page. The person on front desk duty came over promptly to try and get the printer going.
